In January of 2020 I moved in with some friends who told me about New Life for Girls. I entered the program on March 13, 2020, and I graduated April 30, 2022. The Lord wanted me to stay but I chose to go back home instead. I moved in with my brother and quickly started drinking with him again, but God! On August 14, 2022 I visited Dover and decided that I needed to stay. I moved into the children's center about a week later and in August I will celebrate being with them for one year! God has blessed me in so many ways since coming back. For my birthday this year I had some friends visit me, and this month I get to go home and visit with my mom. I never thought I would get my family back, but the Lord has redeemed everything I lost. I have no idea what is in store for me, but I am very excited for what is to come. I know who I am in Christ.
