Asia's Story

Hello. My name is Asia. I am excited to share with you how much Yahweh has changed my life. I was born in New York on a miliary base. My father was in the army and my mother and brother lived on base with him. My parents had been together since they were teenagers. Shortly after my birth, my family moved to Lancaster, PA. I grew up in a strict, church attending household. I was always involved in sports and my parents homeschooled my brother and me. In 7th grade my parents enrolled me in Lancaster Country Day School where my education blossomed, and social skills enhanced.

When I was young, I experienced sexual abuse, and again as a teenager. My parents divorced my senior year of high school and I felt as if my entire family split up. I went from abusive relationships to substance abuse. At 24 I was blessed to have my son, but due to my addiction I lost custody of him when he was 6. Thankfully my brother and sister-in-law took kinship of him. In 2018 I lost my cousin, and in 2020 COVID took my father. My substance abuse continued, and I went from jail to rehab and then back to jail. My mother was accepted to New Life for Girls and my family pushed for me to join her, but I was not ready to change my life. In August 2021 I was 6 months pregnant with my daughter while incarcerated. I was due to have her in 3 months, but the judge gave me a 6-month sentence. That was my rock bottom. I truly met Yahweh in my prison cell, and I cried out to Him for help. The chaplain encouraged me to apply to New Life for Girls, so I did, and they accepted me. The judge allowed me to be released on my due date to NLFG and I was blessed to have my daughter 5 days after my arrival.

Yahweh changed my life, and this ministry was a vessel that He used. While I attended my classes my daughter was able to be overseen by my mother who was working in the nursery. My relationship with my family has been restored. I was granted custody of my son again and God completely filled a void in me I was trying to numb with substances.

I am now in my 3rd phase at the Mothers and Children's Center, and I am learning to rely on Yahweh completely. This ministry has helped me trust my leadership, and they have blessed me and my family so much. I am being filled continually with the Word of God and I am able to attend amazing conferences. I have an intimate relationship with the Creator of the Universe, and He has forever changed my life. I thought I would sober up and get my son back, but I have learned that without God I can do absolutely nothing. I know who I am and whose I am! Hallelujah! I am going to further my education and continue to let the Holy Spirit lead me to my promise land.

I love this scripture I learned while taking the class, Measure of a Woman, and it will forever be written on my heart, "Who can find a virtuous wife? For her worth is far above rubies" (Proverbs 31:10), and "Her children rise up and call her blessed; her husband also, and he praises her" (Proverbs 31:28).




Director's Corner
