Steph's Story

Hi! My name is Steph, and I am 23 years old! There's so much I want to say...but first I want to share with you two of my life verses. John 8:34-36 And psalms 42:1

Now let's get to the nitty gritty. At 15 I was on my own- living with a friend. Going to school in MD while my mom was in PA. My dad only lived a few blocks away from me, but we weren't on speaking terms. This nasty cycle started about a year before moving in with my friend where I literally did what I wanted no matter what anyone said. This girl was filled with so much hurt, anger and betrayal. I was very ignorant and made a lot of mistakes during this time. I grew up as a violent child so this ended up being a part of my life outside of the home. I would get into physical altercations just because I fed off the thrill and adrenaline and I was failing all of my classes, skipping school, or sneaking out of school shortly after arriving.

One random day my mom rolled up with the police to take me back to PA with her. I had such a disconnect between my parents at this time that even though it was the right thing for me to go with her- my heart was hardened, and I wanted nothing to do with her. I started making suicidal threats, cussing her out just being all out ugly and disrespectful; of course she won that battle. We get to PA and BAM! I've never lived somewhere so country!! I couldn't believe seeing the horse and buggy's riding down the street and how small the town of Glen Rock was; not to mention my new high school was tiny. I was shell shocked to say the least. I know now what I didn't know then- I NEEDED THIS. I was so used to the fast life I NEEDED the slow stillness of the country. The Lord began to take me out of this hectic mindset with so many distractions and put me in the middle of nowhere physically and spiritually. I was desolate. This was a slow dreadful process for me- I didn't know just yet but the Lord was already doing what he does best! What the Lord did was started to orchestrate the path for me to meet my now husband. When we met, I started going to youth group with him. The motives were wrong BUT God used that to start softening my heart. His dad was the youth pastor at the time, and every time he preached it could be applied to my life which blew my mind and sparked interest. What really got me though was when I finally went to a service with them for the first time. His parents were guest speakers at a church sharing their testimony. I barely knew them but as they spoke my heart turned from what felt like stone to a pile of mush. For the first time I understood what the power of Jesus Christ's love can do, and that no matter how far gone we are or how big our mistakes, if we repent with our hearts/actions the Lord will forgive us and set us free. This WRECKED me. I never experienced a love like that- I didn't even know it was possible. So, the Lord captivated me ever since that day. I was only 16 years old and my interest grew tremendously, but during this I was still halfway in the world and the first chance I got I found access to the same things I was struggling with in MD. Drugs, alcohol and fighting. When I moved to PA I stopped caring for myself my first year here. I wasn't eating, I started abusing a prescription and I was drastically losing weight. At 17 years old I hit 83 pounds, and at this point there was no hiding it from my loved ones. Something was clearly wrong, but I would never tell them the truth. I went into psychosis due to the prescription drug abuse. I was under a STRONG demonic attack, and the only time I felt safe was when I slept with my Bible. Over time I started living for Him, losing worldly friends and making better life choices through very small baby steps. This was so hard because my husband was still in the world. We had a lot of issues at that time- young, dumb and "in love." There were times I back slid, times I relapsed certain behaviors or addictions, but the Lord knew that wasn't my destiny. He was patient with me. And now here I am almost 7 years later fully surrendered to Him. There's not a single thing or person that will turn me away from God, and I know my life's purpose is to spread the Gospel. To show people it's never too late or too early to start. Now I am a pastor that works part time with teenagers at a faith-based ministry and I am full time senior staff at New Life for mothers and children. A little over a year married to the love of my life and soulmate starting our own family living a BEAUTIFUL life. It has been an honor and a privilege to be able to be a part of building the Lord's Kingdom. It took a lot to get here. Good, bad and ugly. but I wouldn't change it for a thing! It was SO WORTH IT!! I am so grateful and blessed to have been made new! He has completely transformed by identity from the inside out!

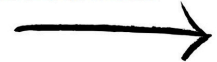
