Ayisha's Story



Hi, my name is Ayisha Charlemagne, and I am one of the youngest ladies living here at New Life Center for Mothers and Children. I am 19 years old, and I was born in Haiti. I was adopted when I was 18 months old, and they brought me to the United States when I was 2. From then on, I had very loving parents until I got older and my behavior started to change. As I got older, I started to notice that the environment around me was becoming toxic and unhealthy. I was taken advantage of by a family member when I was just a child and suffered sexual abuse. I also witnessed abuse happening to others in my family and family members struggling with addiction, and it started to have an effect on me to the point where I was suffering from sleep paralysis at night. I know now looking back it was the devil acting in my life, but I also know at the same time that Jesus was there as well. I tried to get myself help by telling the school that I was being abused, but my parents did nothing and that led me to trying to commit suicide and an attempt at running away. During the times when I would run away, I would find older men that I would try to find comfort and validation in. My behavior kept spiraling out of control to the point where I was putting myself into dangerous situations, and I actually became a victim of human trafficking. When the police found me, my mom tried to put me in psychiatric hospitals. When I would leave those places and go home, I just went right back into an abusive household so the cycle would continue. Then I finally ran away for good and lived on the streets in Langley Park, Maryland. As I was roaming the streets with friends, I found a significant other who was also living on the streets, but he just happened to be a drug dealer as well. At the time, I was 15 years old and he was 21. We started living together, and we found comfort in one another. When I found out I was pregnant at 16, I went back to school. At 17 years old, I gave birth to a very healthy and beautiful little boy who is now 2 years old named Jeremiah. His father and I would get into fights and they were very toxic. This went on for a year. One night when me and Jeremiah's dad were living together, our apartment got raided by the police. This all happened in front of Jeremiah, unfortunately. His father was taken to prison, but it was after that day that I was really able to start seeking the Lord. At 18 years old, I graduated from High School. I got a job at Olive Ole working in customer service and had been there for 2 months and had prayed to God whether he wanted me to keep this job or not, and then a month later, I got fired from my job. The Lord is funny that way. That's when I started putting signs up to start renting out my room. Along the way, the Lord put women in my path from New Life, and they were giving out food for the homeless. I asked them for prayer and deliverance and shared with them my testimony. They immediately told me they would help get me into New Life. The rest is history. I went from New Life for Girls to then New Life for Mother's and Children, where I've been ever since October 2024. Today at New Life I have been set free, and I have been spiritually growing in the Lord everyday. My son is with me and growing in the Lord as well, and I can't wait to see what the Lord has for us in the future.
