Hello! My name is Teri Sheffer, and I am super excited to share how the Lord has radically changed my life. I once lived a life trapped in the chains of addiction, where every day felt like a struggle for survival. My choices led me down a dark path, far from the person I knew I could be. At the height of my addiction, I felt hopeless, lost, and alone. I got locked up, lost my son, my family, and everything that ever mattered to me. I found myself in solitary confinement with only a Bible to read and a rubber pencil. I had lost all hope, but God, in His infinite mercy, had a different plan for me. He intervened in such a way that I knew my life would never be the same. He met me, He saw me, and He healed me as only He can! I left YCP in 2013 with nothing to my name and entered New Life. In 2015, I graduated and became a staff member shortly after. In 2018, I became the assistant director, and although I wish I could say it's been rainbows ever since, that is simply not the case. Truly, I have had the most growing pains since being called into leadership. I have had to learn to give up what I believe to be "right," and fully surrender to His plans. Although it has been challenging, it has been nothing short of miraculous. He took a heroin addict and turned her into a pastor; that is how good my God is!! But that is not all!! About 2 years ago, my son, who is now a Junior in college himself, was struggling navigating both his academic and athletic careers. I would take classes, get high, and then give up, on repeat for years, but I desired to finish what I had started so long ago. Navigating the challenges of school, ministry, and family life was the hardest thing I have ever done, but GOD! As of December 9th, I became a college graduate, that in and of itself is so surreal! When the Lord says lean not on your own understanding, listen! Had I listened to my doubting thoughts I would not be where I am today. I had enough excuses that I had already begun to plan my failure, but the Lord strengthened me and together WE did it! I thank God for those He ordained to be in my life, those that encouraged me and pushed me to succeed. My graduation started as a motivator for my son, but in the end has truly shown me that with Christ, ALL things are possible.
